### PARADE INFORMATION

# \*\*\* PLEASE NOTE - We have two muster points \*\*\*

**Muster Point 1 -** The main parade will start to muster on the Promenade by the East Beach Café/ Sea Road at **1030hrs** before forming up in parade order on **Sea Road** facing in a Westbound Direction **once road closures are confirmed in place**.

**Muster Point 2 –** This point is for veterans or members of the parade who are unable to make the full parade from Arun Parade. Muster on East Green near the vehicle entrance where the parade will enter. **1050hrs** 

The Main Parade will be under the control of the Parade Marshal - Richard Jeffrey

The second muster will be under the control of one of the Parade Assistants - TBC

There will be a short briefing of senior members of organisations to ensure correct positioning in the line-up and in the arena.

### PARADE INFORMATION

The parade marshal will alert the parade and bring them to attention using a long blast of a whistle. The Parade will step off from Sea Road at **1045hrs** heading down towards Norfolk Road then onto South Terrace. Parade continues along before turning left onto East Green through the vehicle entrance before halting near the front gate to the arena to allow persons from muster point 2 to join the parade. Standard bearers will fall out at this point and position themselves at the front gate to the arena.

#### PICK UP OF MUSTER POINT 2 - INFORMATION

Those at muster point 2 will join the parade as it halts outside the arena. There is seating in the arena for anyone who cannot stand for the duration of the service (approx. 15 minutes)

### **PARADE BAND INFORMATION**

The Massed Band will be positioned in the centre of the arena, the Band should leave adequate space behind them to allow organisations to pass behind the band and the arena fencing as well as adequate area in front of the band for the standards to form for the service.

#### **PARADE INFORMATION**

Once each organisation is positioned in the arena. Their organisations Standards / Colours / Flags are to position themselves to the front of their organisations and order their Standard / Colour / Flag.

Once in position the senior member of the organisations are to stand their organization at ease.

### **PARADE BAND INFORMATION**

The massed Band is to continue playing until all organisations are in position on the main arena. Lead Drum Major of the band is to observe the parade marshal who will notify them once the parade is in position.

### **ALTAR PARTY INFORMATION**

Once the band is in the arena and halted. The Altar Party will fall themselves out of the massed band and assemble the Altar so it is ready before the band finishes playing.

On passing the WESTERN FLAG the order EYES FRONT will be given (ideally by either the platoon commander or suitable qualified person at the rear of the platoon) Once all organisations have left the arena the band is to reform and leave the arena. Once out of the arena all organisations are to dismiss their members.


